### Irish Pro-Abortion Groups

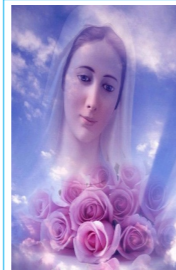
George Soros, one of the richest people in the world gives money to pro-abortion groups. So do Warren Buffett and Mark Zuckerberg, to name just two other super-rich abortion funders. It has long been an open secret that Soros, through his Open Society Foundation, has no qualms about interfering in the affairs of countries all over the world to further his open pet agenda. It is believed that he has spent €10 billion in this way in recent decades.

So in a sense, the leaked documents showing lavish Soros grants to three Irish pro-abortion groups, were hardly surprising. Yet the revelations about a concerted campaign by Soros to fund organisations campaigning to remove the 8th Amendment display arrogance and disregard for democracy that is truly jaw dropping. The Soros group boasts that it can leverage a network of local foundations in over 40 countries. The groups it funds include the Centre for Reproductive Rights responsible for the A, B and C v Ireland case that led to the 2013 Abortion law, the International Women's Health Coalition and Women on Web, the Dutch Group that has orchestrated a series of pro-abortion stunts in Ireland, including the notorious "abortion boat". A leaked strategy document from the Open Society Foundation details how Soros planned to fund Amnesty Ireland, the Abortion Rights Campaign and the Irish Family Planning Association as part of a strategy to force the repeal of the 8th Amendment, to remove the right to life of the unborn child. All of these three groups have admitted to receiving cash.

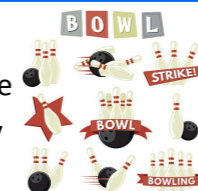


### St. Margaret's Céilí Club
