Feast of the Assumption of Our Blessed Lady

In 1950 Pope Pius XII declared that it was part of the Catholic Faith to believe that the "Immaculate Mother of God, the Blessed Virgin Mary, after completing the course of her life on earth, was assumed to the glory of heaven in body and soul.
