Special Collection

A special collection will take place today in the Church to assist TROCAIRE in their work in East Africa. There are severe food shortages in South Sudan, Somalia, Kenya and Ethiopia brought about by drought and conflict. Over half the population of Somalia (6.2 million people) is experiencing food shortages and malnutrition. There have also been major outbreaks of cholera across the country. South Sudan is on the brink of famine, with drought and conflict affecting millions. Millions of people in south-eastern Ethiopia and northern Kenya are in urgent need of humanitarian assistance. On behalf of Irish Catholics, Trócaire is doing all it possible can - currently helping over 150,000 people across the region with emergency food, water and sanitation.

Questions People Ask

Q. What is the significance of the different colours of vestments at Mass?
A. Green: the colour of growth, is used for most Sundays and weekdays. **Red:** the colour of love, is used for the Holy Spirit, for the Sacred Heart or for the blood of martyrs. **White:** is used at Easter time and for saints other than martyrs. **Purple:** signifies temperance and penance, so it is used in Advent and Lent. **Black** vestments, once common in funeral liturgies are rarely used nowadays. Instead, white may be used to express resurrection, or purple for mourning
