THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION—Friday 10th March

The Church encourages us to have a regular practice of celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation as we live our sacramental Eucharistic life. If we have fallen into serious sin, then, of course we should always "go to confession". before we receive Holy Communion. This is the great sacrament of forgiveness that Christ gave to the Church when he said to the apostles on Easter Sunday "receive the Holy Spirit", for those who you forgive, they are forgiven". We hear these reassuring words of absolution as the priest prays, "God the Father of Mercies, send the Holy Spirit among us for the forgiveness of sins...I absolve you from your sins in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit". The forgiveness of our sins is the work of the Holy Spirit. Not only does the Holy Spirit forgive all our sins but the spirit also heals the wounds and the sins that others have inflicted on us.
