Baptism The Beginning of the Journey

Our faith does not remain the same. It either grows or withers. So regular attendance at Sunday Mass is important when you come to present your child for Baptism. It is a sign of your contact with the welcoming community. How can you expect your child to travel the way of faith if you do not travel the same way yourself. It is not enough to have your child baptised. You must show that child the way of faith by the example of your own life. Becoming a Christian involves a lifelong process beginning with parents. At the ceremony you are reminded of this.

"You must make it your constant care to bring him/her up in the practice of faith, see that the divine life which God has given him/her is kept safe from the poison of sin, always to grow stronger". Finally a word about godparents. Their duty is to help parents and be models of Christian living. They should be mature, not less than 16yrs of age and have the intention of carrying out their duty. One of them is expected to sponsor the child when it comes to confirmation.

Baptisms take place in St. Canices Church on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of Each month immediately after the 12noon Mass. . For bookings contact the Parish Office 01-8343110

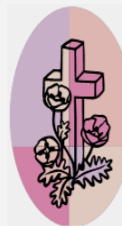
