Questions People Ask

Q. What is the significance of the different colours of vestments at Mass?

A. Green: the colour of growth, is used for most Sundays and weekdays. **Red:** the colour of love, is used for the Holy Spirit, for the Sacred Heart or for the blood of martyrs. **White:** is used at Easter time and for saints other than martyrs. **Purple:** signifies temperance and penance, so it is used in Advent and Lent. **Black** vestments, once common in funeral liturgies are rarely used nowadays. Instead, white may be used to express resurrection, or purple for mourning

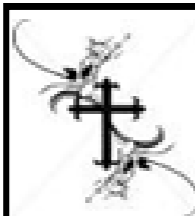
