DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Divine Mercy celebration takes place in the Church of Annunciation on Sunday April 3rd commencing with confession at 2.30pm and concluding with Mass at 4pm. Celebrant Fr. Michael Shiels. The Divine Mercy Devotion similar to devotion to the Sacred Heart, had its origin in the now approved revelations



made to St. Faustina Kowalska (1905-1938).

The devotion has the blessing of the Church and was especially promulgated by Pope John 11 who declared Sister Faustina a saint on 30th April 2000.

The Divine Mercy image is the image of the Risen Christ on that first Easter on the evening of the Resurrection, miraculously appearing in the upper room and bestowing on the Apostles the power of the Holy Spirit to forgive sins. His hand is raised in blessing, he shows them His wounds, and Jesus is looking for their trust.

The Resurrection of the Lord



Today is the greatest feast of the Church's year. No other event in the story of our salvation, no other event in all recorded history of the Church can compare to this day.

For on this day we celebrate Christ's resurrection, his victory over death.

On this day we celebrate the fact that we are a redeemed people, and our salvation has already taken place. On Easter morning, when the apostles discovered the empty tomb, they were puzzled. Then it began to dawn on them. Jesus had risen from the dead, just as he said he would. For them and for us nothing would ever be the same again. For through the resurrection of Jesus, we have been freed from the dead too. His resurrection means we share in his victory—that life not death is our destiny. When we die, we do not pass from life to death, we pass from life to life. Because Christ lives, we live. That is the good news to day—the basis of our faith without which there would be no Church, no Christianity and no hope for us.
